The sacrifice of diggers in past and present conflicts was commemorated at hundreds of Remembrance Day ceremonies across Australia this week.

While no World War 1 diggers remain, their family, friends and schools such as NVCCS took part in ceremonies across the country to remember their sacrifice.

A minutes silence was observed during the Monday Assembly at NVCCS as the students remembered those who fought for our freedom in the many wars and conflicts during the past century and those still on active service today.

The School Captains, Abby Scott and Daniel Bagnell, (Year 12) and Hope Spriggs (Year 6) and, Harrison Usher (Vice Captain, Year 6) laid wreaths at the Nambucca Heads Cenotaph at 11am on Saturday 11 November, 2017.

The Unknown Soldier has come to symbolize the bravery and sacrifice of troops, and that ordinary people "were not ordinary at all during the war". The Unknown Australian Soldier interred in the Australian War Museum, Canberra reminds us of these lessons, as much as he reminds us of the thousands of Australians lost to us by war.

Those who have served our country have shown courage under pressure, ingenuity in adversity, bonds of mateship and above all, loyalty to Australia.

The Bible teaches us that Jesus surrendered His life on a cross in obedience to God the Father. This was God's plan.

It was heroic and deliberate and was for people like you and me! Romans 5:7-9 says, *"For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His love for us, in that while we were sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him ."*

Jesus' sacrifice means that *"whoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life"* John 3:16. Jesus' name is at the top of God's Honour Panel.

Philippians 2:8-11 *"He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death even the death of the cross. Therefore God has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven, and on earth, and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the Glory of God the Father."*

It is a great time to remember our heroic soldiers. It is also timely to remember the ultimate hero—Jesus—who provides eternal life to all who believe in Him. He did this while we were His enemies.
